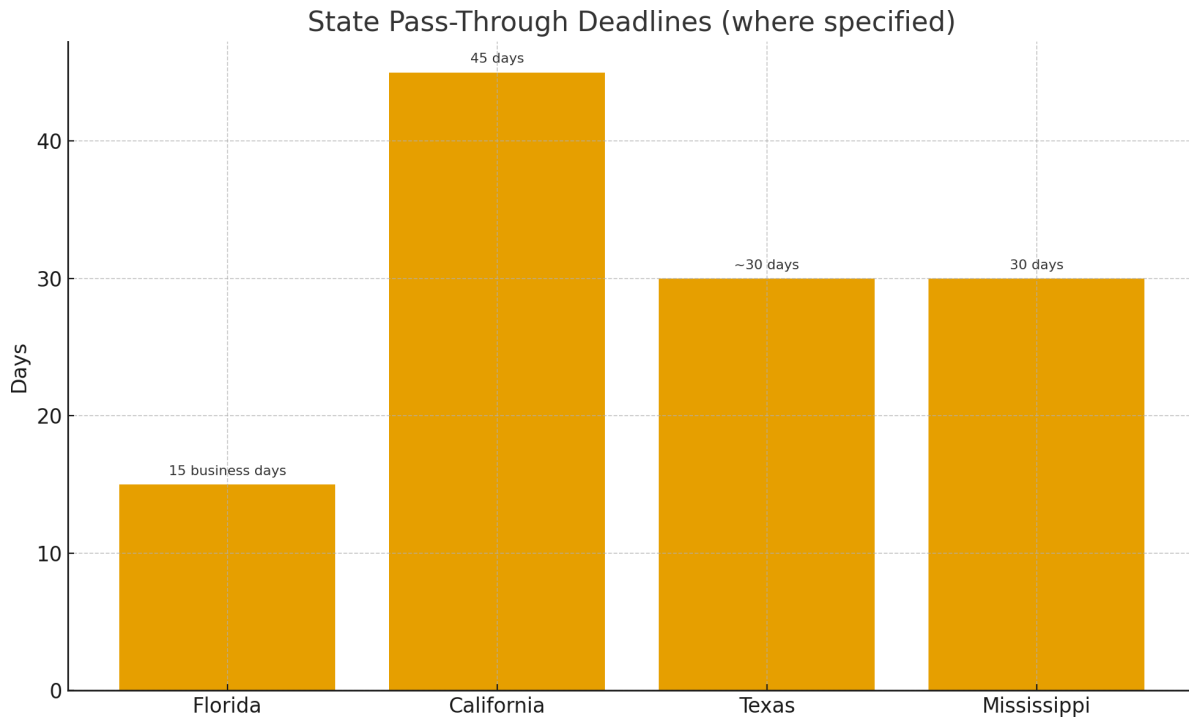


FEMA Public Assistance (PA) – Executive Summary (Pass-Through Rules)

Quick comparison of state/territory pass-through timelines, payment models, and systems. Federal anchors apply across all: 2 CFR 200.305 (cash management), 44 CFR 206.205 (PA payment), Stafford Act §705(c).

FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Florida

Recipient: Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM)

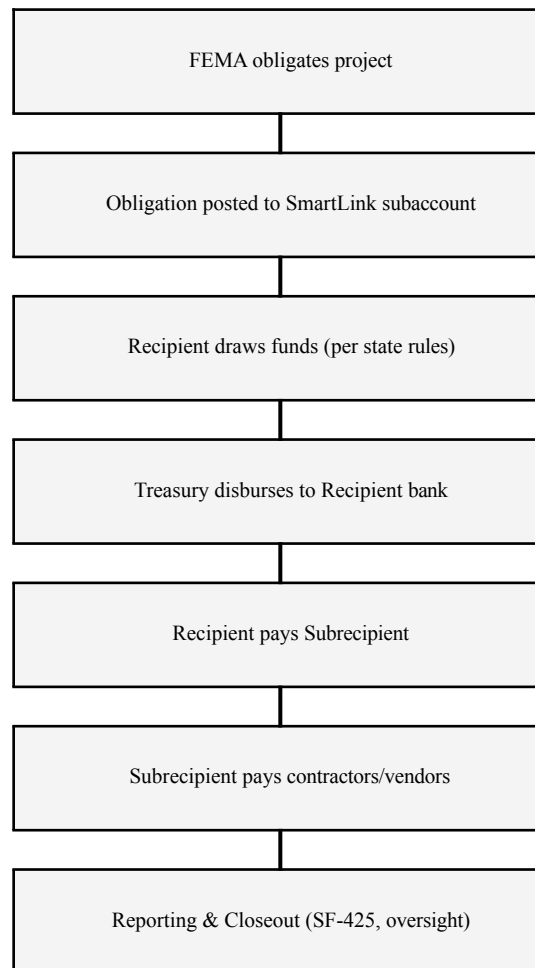
Pass-through: Must transfer FEMA funds to Subrecipients within **15 business days** of receipt.

Statute: Fla. Stat. §252.37; Fla. Admin. Code 27P.

System: FloridaPA.org.

Model: Mix of advances (small projects) and reimbursement (large projects).

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Puerto Rico

Recipient: COR3 (Central Office for Recovery, Reconstruction & Resiliency)

Pass-through: Disburses only after validation via DRFFM system.

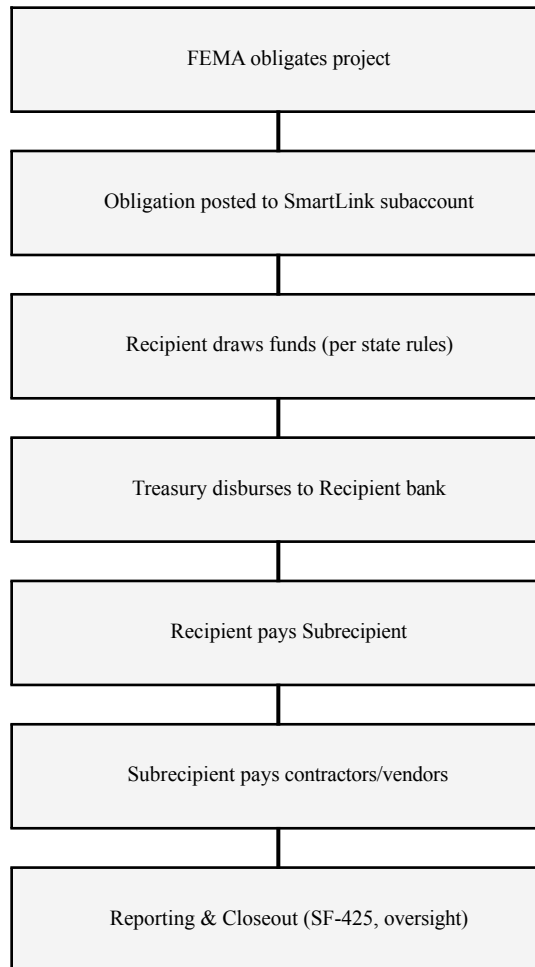
Oversight: PROMESA fiscal control; centralized disbursement.

Statute: COR3 Federal Funds Management Manual; PROMESA §101.

System: DRFFM + Puerto Rico Treasury.

Model: Reimbursement-heavy, central validation before payout.

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Texas

Recipient: Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM)

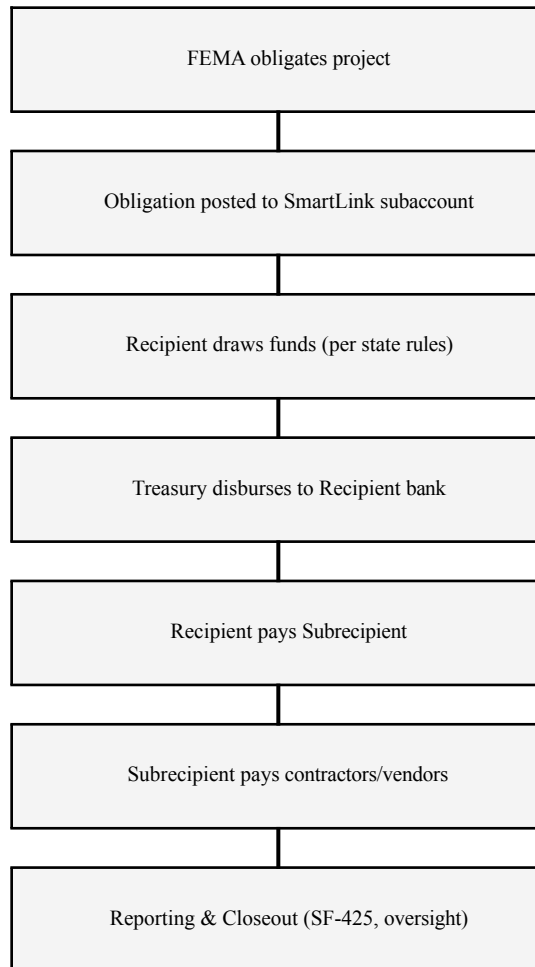
Pass-through: Within ~30 days when documentation complete.

Statute: Texas Admin. Code, Title 37, Part 1, Ch. 7, Subch. E.

System: Texas GMS portal

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).

Model: Reimbursement-based; advances rare.



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Montana

Recipient: Montana Disaster & Emergency Services (DES)

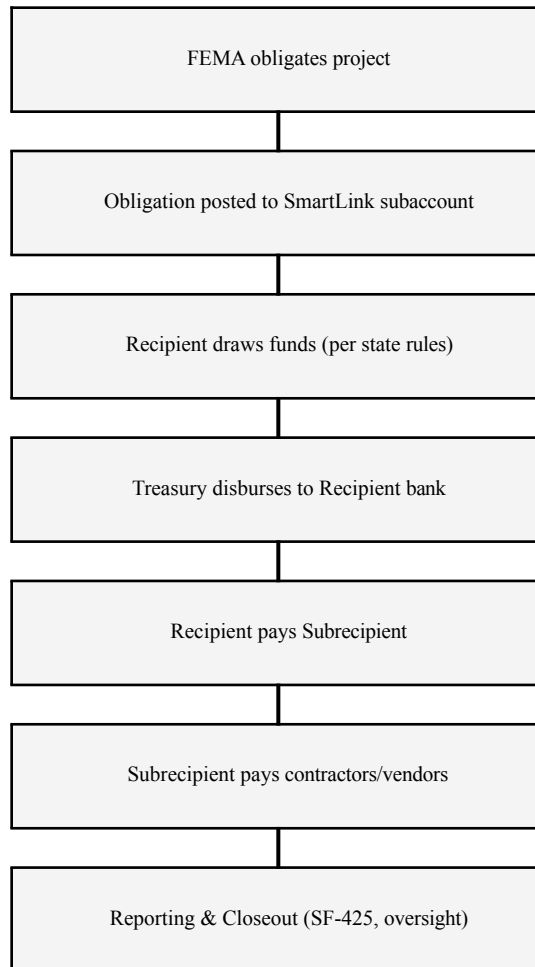
Pass-through: Follows “as soon as practicable” federal rule.

Statute: Montana Code Annotated, Title 10, Ch. 3.

System: SIGMA (Montana's Grants & Loans portal)

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305, 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).

Model: Primarily reimbursement, some advances for small jurisdictions.



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – California

Recipient: California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES)

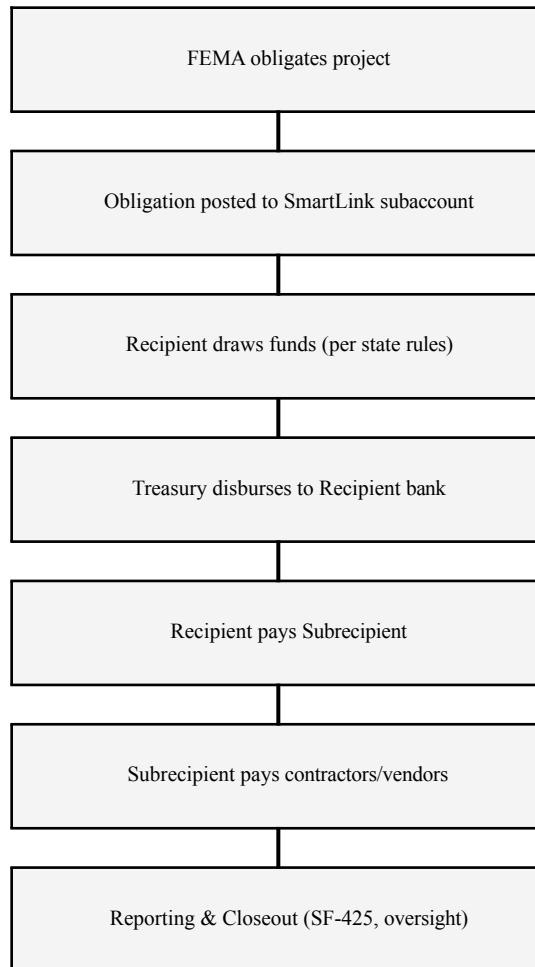
Pass-through: Within **45 days** of receipt of FEMA funds.

Statute: Cal. Gov't Code §8686; Cal OES Grant Guidelines.

System: Cal OES Grants Portal

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).

Model: Mix of advance and reimbursement; layered reviews.



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Louisiana

Recipient: Governor's Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Preparedness (GOHSEP)

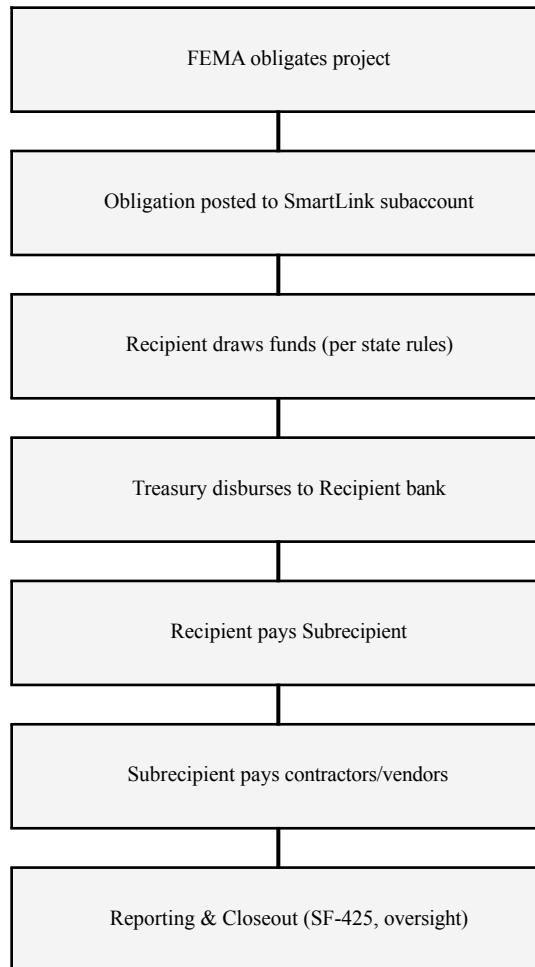
Pass-through: "As soon as practicable," documentation required.

Statute: Louisiana Revised Statutes, Title 29 (Homeland Security & Emergency Preparedness).

System: LAPA portal

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).

Model: Reimbursement; advances rare.



FEMA Public Assistance (PA) Funds Flow – Mississippi

Recipient: Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA)

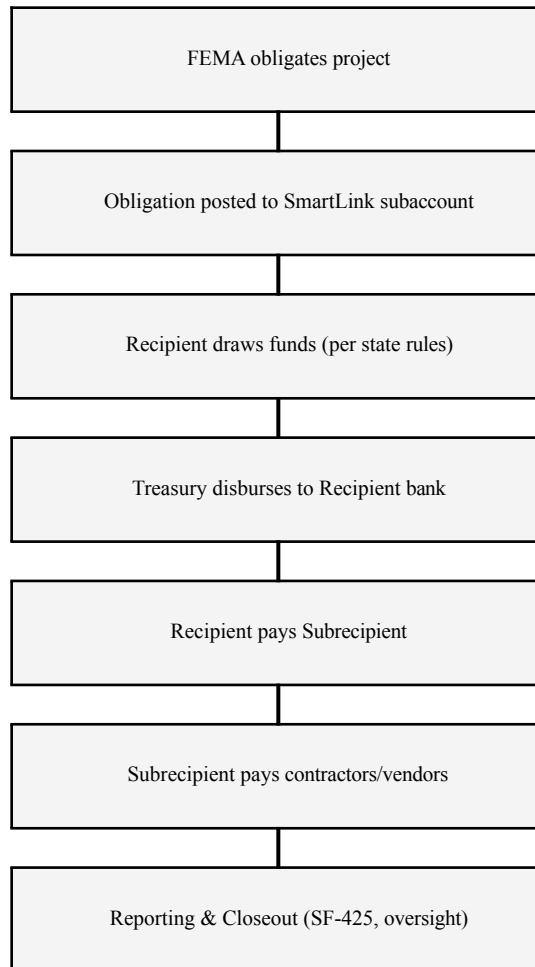
Pass-through: Generally **30 days**, reimbursement model.

Statute: Miss. Code §33-15-307; MEMA PA guidance.

System: MEMA PA Portal

Federal Anchors: 2 CFR 200.305; 44 CFR 206.205; Stafford Act §705(c).

Model: Reimbursement with 3-day disbursement rule applied to Subrecipients.
